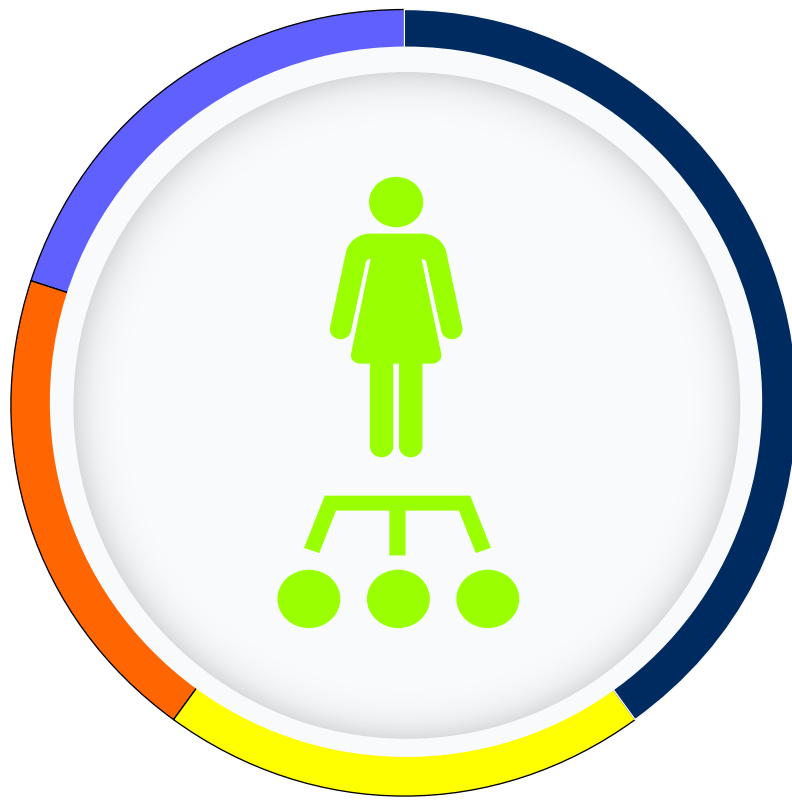

LEADERSHIP IMPACT

- Pilot programs were revamped to meet the most pressing needs of the women being served.
- Ready to Empower (RTE) received nonprofit status.
- Founder, Amanda Ready, created **Árbol De Esperanza (ADE)**, a Costa Rica based organization designed to be solely run by Costa Ricans and to serve as a sister organization to RTE.
- ADE established a jewelry program to offer additional jobs to women.
- The company One Fund created a documentary video on the work RTE and ADE were accomplishing in Costa Rica.
- Continued funding was accomplished through online fundraising campaigns and personal contributions from Ready.
- New office space was secured.
